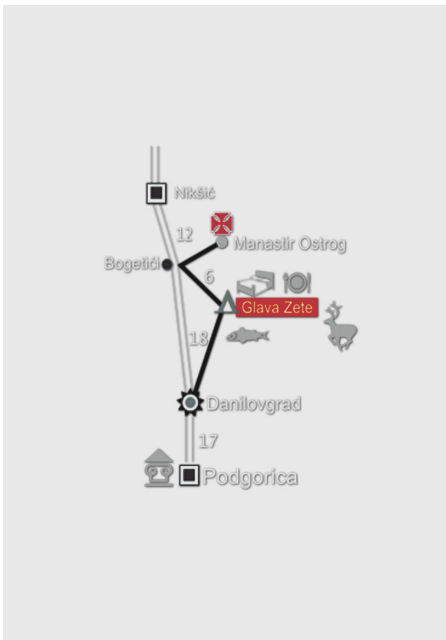


The REACT 2009 is situated in small village Glava Zete in Danilovgrad municipality (Central Montenegro). This village, according to many visitors, is one of the most beautiful villages.

Glava Zete is located on international highway Podgorica-Sarajevo, so there are two directions possible to take toward Glava Zete:

- A) Podgorica -(34km) -Danilovgrad-(10km)- Bogetici (7km)- Glava Zete
- Aa) Podgorica -(34km) -Danilovgrad-(19) – Glava Zete – this is the old road
- B) Sarajevo- (182)- Niksic-(19km)- Bogetici -(7km)- Glava Zete



Please bring some object that will represent your country or your town (dress of sport club, map, flag, etc....)

- A spot where the road branches to Glava Zete is between Danilovgrad and Bogetici. It will be clearly marked. We recommend arrival by your own car but for participants that are not able to come by their own car we will arrange transport. Parking area is provided.
- Participants will be hosted in the hostel “Glava Zete“, which is situated near the Zeta river, one of the most beautiful rivers of Montenegro. The hostel has rooms with air-condition, the restaurant, swimming pools, football and tennis courts.
- The nearest post-office is in Danilovgrad, yet during the REACT 2009 organizer will provide internet service. We suggest Promonte (Telenor) mobile network as it has excellent signal coverage.
- The food is all of national cuisine, of domestic origin, from naturally cultivated products in this region. **If you have any special requirements about food please inform us on time.**

- Apart from cultural and entertaining programme, organizer will supply movie projections, chessboards as well as other forms of amusement. We recommend to use more of your spare time for walks through magnificent ambience.
- The participants will be lodged in two-bed and three-bed apartments. **So please be prepared to share living space with your colleagues from other countries.**
- The clothes is your choice but should be informal, sportive and that make you feel comfortable. The weather forecast reports sunny days, nevertheless do not forget to take some warm cloths (as nights could be a bit chilly), and as our plan includes rafting . Do not forget to take shorts and swimming suits.
- The currency in use in Montenegro is euro(€) and it has different relation to tolar,crona,dinar, denar, kuna, KM and lek. Regarding that this relations vary, we suggest you to check about it in your countries.
